

Jurisdictional Urban Runoff Management Plan Annual Report Fiscal Year 2011-12

1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

This JURMP Annual Report is submitted in partial fulfillment of the requirements of Order No. R9-2007-0001. It is presented in the standardized format developed collectively by the Copermittees and is based on the most updated information available prior to its preparation. It contains descriptions of the County's programs implemented for Fiscal Year (FY) 2011-12 (July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2012) and evaluates their effectiveness where available data and information will support such analysis.

Extensive use of acronyms and abbreviations is made throughout the JURMP Annual Report. Since individual sections do not contain keys, the following list is provided for convenience:

1.2 Purpose and Objectives

The County of San Diego (County) has prepared this JURMP Annual Report in compliance with RWQCB Order R9-2007-0001 (Permit). Its purpose is to report the progress of the County's programs and strategies to reduce the discharge of pollutants of concern to the MS4 and receiving waters. It describes the implementation of the County's JURMP during FY 2011-12 and reports progress in achieving targeted measurable outcomes. In reviewing the FY 2011-12 JURMP Annual Report, the following should be noted:

- Most major sections and sub-sections begin by presenting a figure illustrating a program implementation and assessment strategy. The elements presented in these figures are then used as an organizing framework for the detailed results tables that follow.
- The structure of the JURMP Annual Report closely parallels that of the JURMP. It is recommended that the JURMP be used as a resource when reviewing the Annual Report.
- The JURMP Annual Report has a very strong emphasis on the tabular presentation of data in almost all sections. Supporting discussion is provided as applicable throughout these tables.
- Where possible, the JURMP Annual Report identifies targeted measurable outcomes that are applicable to significant program activities, BMPs, or other relevant JURMP outcomes.

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- In addition to presenting current year results, implementation targets for the upcoming fiscal year are presented where applicable. Not only does this ensure that County programs remain strategic and measurable, but it helps to provide continuity for JURMP Annual Report reviewers from year to year.
- Sections 8.0, 9.0, 11.0, and 14.0 provide summarized information only. Additional detailed information can be found in the source sections referenced within them (primarily **Sections 2.0** through **6.0**). Section 7 and attachments will be submitted separately by December 15, 2012.
