### 14.0 JURMP REVISIONS

*Permit Sections I.1.b* and *J.3.a.(3)(m)* require that the County, based on results of its effectiveness assessment, annually review its jurisdictional activities and BMPs to identify modifications and improvements needed to maximize JURMP effectiveness, and describe these modifications in each JURMP Annual Report. The JURMP was again reviewed during annual report development for FY 2011-12, and no substantial modifications were identified. Various JURMP modifications were previously identified in the FY 2009-10 annual report; however after further review these modifications do not appear to warrant modification of the JURMP at this time.
