

# Hydromodification and SUSMP Public Workshop

You are invited to attend a presentation and stakeholder outreach meeting on the efforts led by the County of San Diego on behalf of the regional Copermittees on developing the Interim Hydromodification Management Criteria and updates to the Regional Model Standard Urban Storm Water Mitigation Plan (Model SUSMP) in compliance with San Diego Regional Water Quality Control Board Order No. R9-2007-0001. These proposed development standards will be incorporated into stormwater requirements for the County of San Diego and all incorporated cities. The Workshop will be held at:

## Topics Covered

**Interim Hydromodification Management Criteria** – Copermittees are establishing new criteria to manage post-project runoff rates and durations from Priority Development Projects greater than 50 acres that would otherwise cause an increase in erosion or significant adverse impacts to beneficial uses. These Interim Criteria will be implemented in January 2008. The Copermittees will be developing the Final Hydromodification Management Criteria over the course of 2008 with the assistance of a Technical/Stakeholder Advisory Committee.

**Update to the Standard Urban Storm Water Mitigation Plan (SUSMP)** – The SUSMP prescribes a method for selecting Best Management Practices (BMPs) based on the pollutants that will be generated at the site and their effectiveness in removing the targeted pollutants. The Copermittees have been collaboratively updating their local SUSMPs to include updated information on permanent treatment control BMPs and Low Impact Development (LID) BMPs. The Copermittees will be developing a more comprehensive update of the regional Model SUSMP by July 2008.
