The District will provide irrigation equipment, conservation devices, and brochures for the visitors of the Water Conservation Garden at Cuyamaca College. Conservation devices include soil probes, irrigation kits, catch cans, and water saving hose nozzles.

As outdoor water use constitutes 50% of water used by most customers, this project will promote water conservation through distribution of these devices at all special events, seminars, and demonstration classes.

Funding will allow distribution of these devices from fiscal years 2003, 2004, and 2005.
