Project summary:

This is a regional project designed to provide mutual aid. Project would provide an emergency treated water supply to Poway should the Lester J. Berglund plant be inoperable. Project is identified in the SDCWA Regional Water Facilities Master Plan.

Project Goal(s) and Benefit(s):

Project would provide a temporary and limited supply of treated water source to Poway should the Lester J. Berglund Water Treatment Plant become inoperable. The project would provide treated water to the citizens of Poway. The City of Poway is supplied from the plant. Currently, there is no emergency treated water connection between Poway and the SDCWA aqueduct. Should routine major maintenance be required at the plant, or a catastrophic failure occurs, Poway would be without treated water. It is essential that the City of Poway have an alternative source of treated water.
