Project summary:

This project consists of construction of a treated water pump station, 5700 linear feet of 30-in steel pipeline, and a new untreated water pump station that will assure a reliable supply of treated and untreated water to the Ramona Area. This project is part of an integrated water management plan designed to improve will provide a second supply line from CWA treated water system to the Ramona area, thus improving reliability and accommodating current growth.

Project Goal(s) and Benefit(s):

This project will improve the reliability of the treated water supply to Ramona and is consistent with integrated water management planning in the region. As part of the mitigation for this project the District will be adding as many as 15 acres to the Blue Sky Reserve in the City of Poway.

The project is under construction and the District has contracted for long lead items. The General Contractor has been selected and construction started in January 2003.
