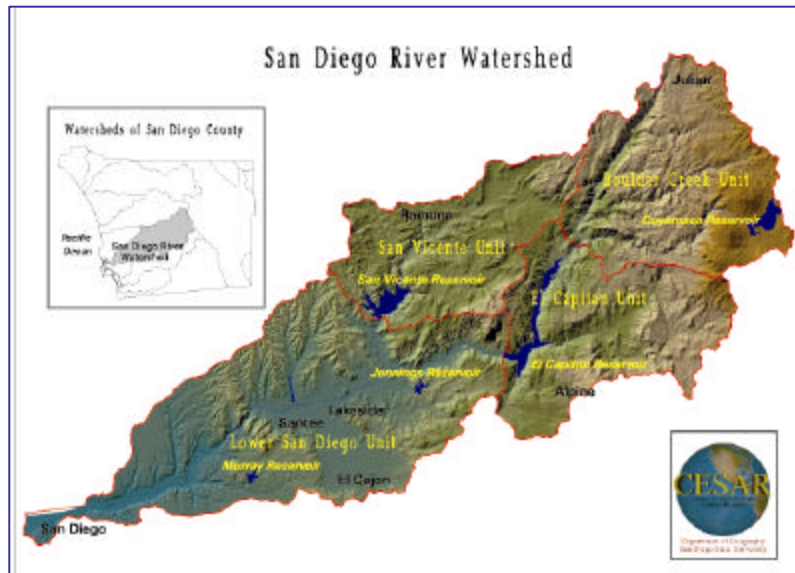


# PUBLIC WORKSHOPS
