2002 CLEAN WATER SUMMIT PLANNING TRACK

New action items identified during the group discussion at the 2002 Summit and confirmed by the TAC and Steering Committee:

1. Install a message board on the Comprehensive Planning TAC website homepage.
2. Identify and characterize the linkages between watershed planning and other planning efforts so that a balance in planning processes and other elements (i.e., quality of life, water quality, etc.) may be achieved.
3. Facilitate integration of scientific and technical information to encourage their use in watershed management planning (i.e., geology, hydrology, biology, GIS, etc.).
4. Expand partnerships to ensure that planning encompasses entire hydrologic units.
5. Facilitate integration of watershed planning and water quality principles into planning curriculums.
