1. Review of Statistical Evaluations of the Historical Mass Loading Station Data -Weston Solutions gave a presentation for agenda items 1,3,4 and 5 and is attached.
2. Review of Watershed Leads Input for Temporary Upstream Stations and Preferred Options -WURMP leads provided input as to their preference for temporary upstream mass loading stations if an option selected included this. A compilation will be provided at the next meeting.
3. Ambient Bay & Lagoon Monitoring Options - See attached presentation- This will be further discussed at next meeting.
4. Statistical Evaluations of Bioassessment Data - See attached presentation. The data support bioassessment monitoring twice a year.
5. Draft Regional Monitoring Program for Discussion including Mass Loading Stations, Ambient Bay and Lagoon Monitoring, and Bioassessment Monitoring - See attached presentation. The group favored Option 1 at this time, but due to time constraints, additional discussion was postponed to the next meeting. Option 1 includes sampling annually, but not in all watersheds each year throughout the 5-year permit term.
6. Dry Weather Program – Analytical analyses – This item was tabled until the next meeting due to time constraints.
7. Wrap-up and Review of Action Items –

Phil Hammer of the RWQCB sent a May 6 letter with additional data request to support the Copermittees October 1, 2004 request for a Monitoring Program Change. The Workgroup supported providing the RWQCB with the requested information. The County of San Diego will find out when the information is needed by the RWQCB and coordinate a schedule with Weston Solutions.

Weston will update watershed maps to include WURMP leads requests for temporary upstream watershed assessment stations. Weston will re-evaluate costs and how the bioassessment and ABLM Programs integrate into Option 1. This will be presented at the next meeting- in Carlsbad- on Tuesday, May 17 from 10 am to noon, located at the Faraday Facility.
